Resolutions

1. The onset of the Corona pandemic altered the process of procurement and subsequent analysis of students' feedback. The feedback in printed form were obtained from the third-year students as they physically came to college to collect their Admit Cards (29.09.20 to 01.10.20). Feedbacks were subsequently collected on a later date and placed for analysis in this meeting.

Feedback of the students show that the academic and administrative status of the college is satisfactory. Two important drawbacks noted are:

a. Classroom shortage in the Arts' Building of the college.

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- b. Need of a Computer Centre
- 2. Women's Cell has organized a sensitization programme in association with Samaj Kalyan MahilaUnnayan Kendra - NGO, registered under WB Society Registration Act. (Reg. No. IL/5999) for both male & female students: "Engaging Ethics in Gender Equality: Towards an Equitable Campus Life" on 08.03.20.
- 3. AIDS Awareness Rally by NSS in association with Chandnichakhat Association Rural Social & Health Advancement NGO with NitiAyog Registration (Number – WB/2009/0007411) has been successfully accomplished on 01.12.19. NSS has celebrated NSS Day (24.09.19) and National Youth Day (12.01.20). It has organized Fit India programme in its own way on 17.01.20.
- 4. 07 permanent teachers against substantive vacancies and 21 SACTs have enhanced the college's teaching community.
- 5. College data has been uploaded to NIRF
- 6. Students of the college have obtained 1st position in district level Quiz Competition and stood 3rd in district level Youth Parliament Competition.
- 7. Utilization of RUSA Fund through on-line tender under eProcurement System of Govt. of West Bengal (Tender Ref. Nos. WBPWD/EE/BDI/eNIT 4/19-20, dt. 11.07.19, WBPWD/EE/BDI/eNIT 7/19-20, dt. 02.09.2019& NIT01/2019-20 dt. 08.03.20) has been undertaken. Construction of building is ongoing. Computers, laptops and peripherals have been received on 05.06.20.
- 8. To enhance ICT purchase of 8 desktops using College Fund has been done.
- 9. Pay-Fixation of all staff members as per 7th Pay Commission through HRMS-iFMS, Govt. of West Bengal, was undertaken on a work-from-home basis. And the same has been successfully accomplished.

 - c. Introduction of NCC from the next session
 - d. Since campus is closed because of Corona pandemic, IQAC urges for continuation of online classes, disbursement of e-materials to students, organizing extension lectures and webinars by departments in particular and the college in general.
 - e. Development of skills of the students by inculcating core values among them by imparting value-based e-education.
 - f. Enhancing social compatibility of the students by giving better opportunity of social interaction through activities of NSS as and when campus re-opens.
 - g. Enhancement of infrastructural facilities to enhance ICT, particularly in classroom setup without jeopardizing Covid protocol.
 - h. Submission of Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) to NAAC at the earliest feasible opportunity.
 - i. Introduction of online Feedback system.
 - j. Green Audit and its follow up action as and when campus reopens.
 - k. Augmentation of library infrastructure utilizing RUSA 2.0 funds.
