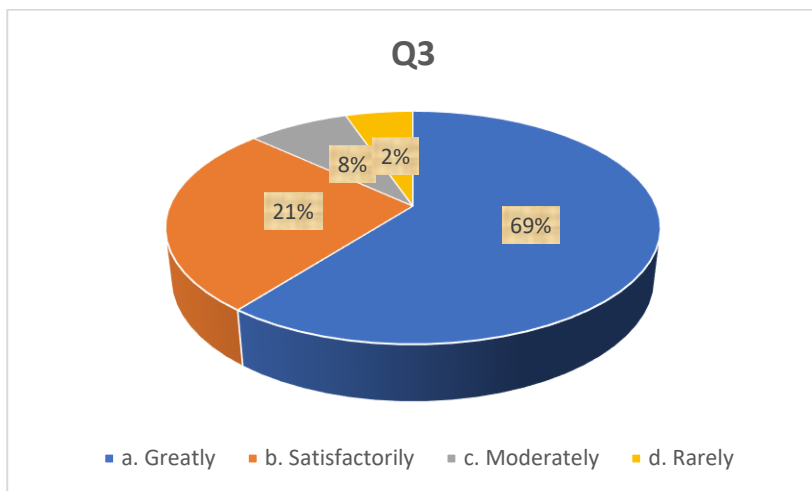
Q1. Is Syllabus/Course Curriculum based on the current needs of the students?



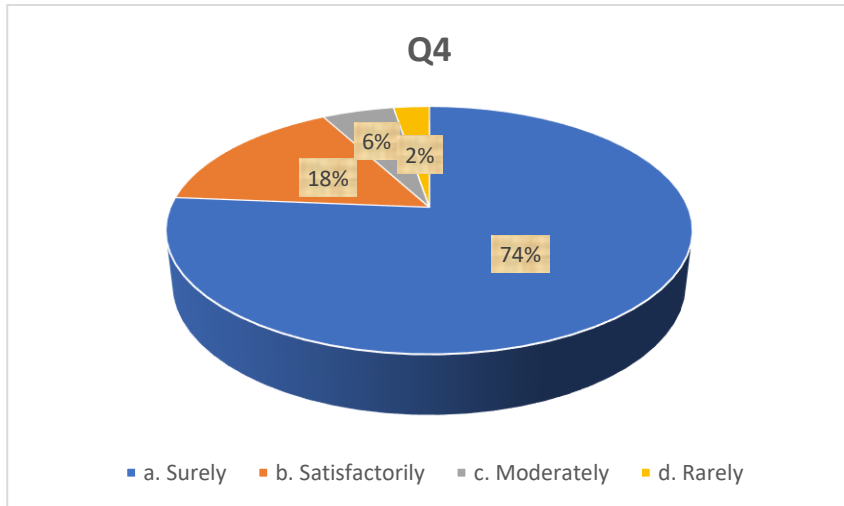

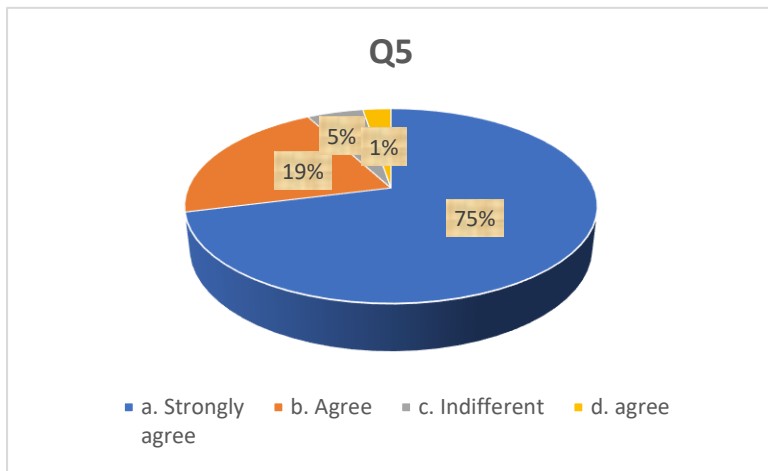

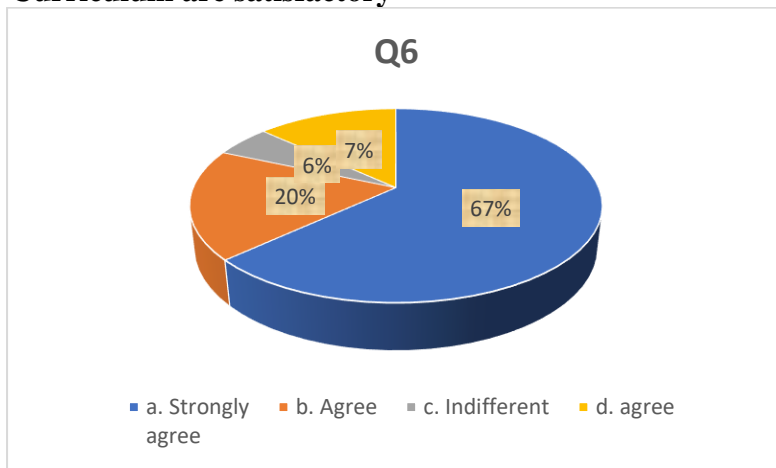
**Q4. Do you consider that current Course Curriculum is sufficient to generate employability skill among the students?**



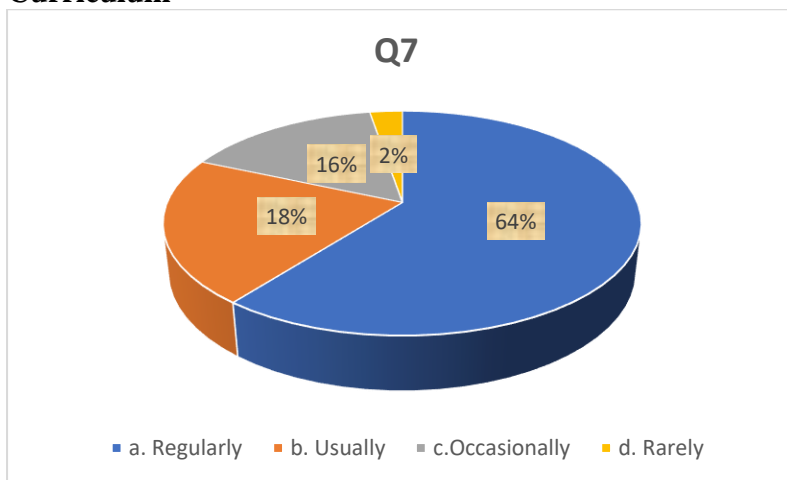
